Dear Liz,

United Airlines hereby accepts the Function 7.3 IATA accredited training program provided by WFS Academy for use by the cargo acceptance service provider at CDG. United has determined that the training meets the requirements set forth in ICAO Regulations and is therefore in compliance with 14CFR121 Appendix O.

In addition to successful completion of the training course, DG acceptance personnel must also successfully complete United Airlines' differences training. The differences training curriculum is administered by United Cargo's training organization via the Take-Off Learning network. Function 7.2 personnel who accept non-DG cargo or mail and Function 7.4 personnel who are responsible for handling/loading/storage of cargo or mail must complete United's DG General Familiarization and Cargo DG Generalist (function specific) training.

Dangerous Goods training records shall be maintained and made available in accordance with ICAO Technical Instructions Part 7 Section 4.10 and 14CFR121.1005 for all employees who will handle United Airlines cargo and/or flights.
